


Certification Standard of the Appraisal Institute

Effective February 20, 2015

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- 1 A Certification for a Written Report Must Also Include Statements
- 2 Relating to Special Commitments Made by Appraisal Institute
- 3 Members, Candidates and Practicing Affiliates
- 4 Certification Standard Rules
- 5 **C.S.R. 1-1**
- 6 Each written report must contain a certification that includes the following statement:
- The reported analyses, opinions and conclusions were developed, and this report has been prepared,
- 8 in conformity with the requirements of the Code of Professional Ethics and Standards of Professional
- 9 Appraisal Practice of the Appraisal Institute.
- 10 Comment
- 11 Members, Candidates and Practicing Affiliates must use the exact text of the statement required by this
- 12 Rule.
- 13 **C.S.R. 1-2**
- 14 Each written report must contain a certification that includes the following statement:
- The use of this report is subject to the requirements of the Appraisal Institute relating to review by its
- 16 duly authorized representatives.
- 17 Comment
- 18 Members, Candidates and Practicing Affiliates must use the exact text of the statement required by this
- 19 Rule.
- 20 **C.S.R. 1-3**
- 21 Each written report of a Designated Member must contain a certification that includes one of the following
- statements, whichever is appropriate:
- 23 Either
- As of the date of this report, I (or Designated Member(s) name(s)) have/has completed the
- continuing education program for Designated Members of the Appraisal Institute.
- 26 Or
- As of the date of this report, I (or Designated Member(s) name(s)) have not/has not completed
- the continuing education program for Designated Members of the Appraisal Institute.

- 30 Under the continuing education program of the Appraisal Institute, Designated Members who complete
- 31 the Standards Requirement, Ethics Requirement and Points Requirement in a five (5) year cycle are
- deemed "continuing education completed."
- Certification Standard Rule 1-3 requires that all Designated Members include in the certifications of their
- 34 written reports a statement whether they have completed the continuing education program and are
- 35 therefore "continuing education completed." Those Designated Members who do not hold the status
- 36 "continuing education completed" must include in the certifications of their written reports a statement that
- 37 they have not completed the continuing education program of the Appraisal Institute, regardless of
- whether they are required to complete the Points Requirement.
- 39 Because this Certification Standard Rule applies only to Designated Members, it is inappropriate for
- 40 Candidates, Practicing Affiliates and non-members to use either of the statements found in C.S.R. 1-3.
- 41 Designated Members must use the exact text of the statement required by this Rule. If a Designated
- 42 Member seeks to explain his or her failure to complete the continuing education program of the Appraisal
- Institute for Designated Members, extreme care must be used. The Appraisal Institute does not deem
- other activities as equivalent to its continuing education program. Misleading statements that relate to a
- 45 Designated Member's qualifications violate Ethical Rule 5-5 of the Code of Professional Ethics.
- 46 Misleading statements of any kind may violate Ethical Rule 1-1(a) of the Code of Professional Ethics.

47 <u>C.S.R. 1</u>-4

- 48 Except as provided below, each written report of a Candidate must contain a certification that includes
- one of the following statements, whichever is appropriate:
- 50 Either
- As of the date of this report, I (or name(s)) have/has completed the Standards and Ethics
- 52 Education Requirements for Candidates of the Appraisal Institute.
- 53 Or
- As of the date of this report, I (or name(s)) have not/has not completed the Standards and Ethics
- 55 Education Requirements for Candidates of the Appraisal Institute.
- 56 Comment
- Pursuant to Appraisal Institute Regulation Nos. 1, 2 and 3, Candidates must complete Standards and
- 58 Ethics Education Requirements within the first year of candidacy.
- 59 Certification Standard Rule 1-4 requires that all Candidates must include in the certifications of their
- written reports a statement whether they have completed the applicable Standards and Ethics Education
- 61 Requirements.
- 62 Because this Certification Standard Rule applies only to Candidates, it is inappropriate for Designated
- 63 Members, Practicing Affiliates and non-members to use the statements found in C.S.R. 1-4.

- 64 Candidates must use the exact text of the statement required by this Rule. If a Candidate seeks to explain
- 65 his or her failure to complete the Standards and Ethics Education Requirements of the Appraisal Institute
- 66 for Candidates, extreme care must be used. Misleading statements that relate to a Candidate's
- qualifications violate Ethical Rule 5-5 of the Code of Professional Ethics. Misleading statements of any
- 68 kind may violate Ethical Rule 1-1(a) of the Code of Professional Ethics.

69 **C.S.R. 1-5**

- 70 Except as provided below, each written report of a Practicing Affiliate must contain a certification that
- 71 includes one of the following statements, whichever is appropriate:
- 72 Either
- As of the date of this report, I (or name(s)) have/has completed the Standards and Ethics
- The Education Requirements for Practicing Affiliates of the Appraisal Institute.
- 75 Or
- As of the date of this report, I *(or name(s))* have not/has not completed the Standards and Ethics Education Requirements for Practicing Affiliates of the Appraisal Institute.
- 78 On or after July 1, 2015, once a Practicing Affiliate who is not an Appraisal Institute Designated Member
- has completed at least one five (5) year continuing education cycle in which he or she was required to
- 80 fulfill the Points and Standards and Ethics Education Requirements, such Practicing Affiliate must include
- 81 in the certifications of his or her written reports one of the following statements, whichever is appropriate:
- 82 Either
- As of the date of this report, I *(or name(s))* have/has completed the continuing education program for Practicing Affiliates of the Appraisal Institute.
- 85 Or
- As of the date of this report, I *(or name(s))* have not/has not completed the continuing education program for Practicing Affiliates of the Appraisal Institute.
- 88 Comment
- 89 Certification Standard Rule 1-5 requires that except as provided below, all Practicing Affiliates must
- 90 include in the certifications of their written reports a statement whether they have completed the
- 91 applicable Standards and Ethics Education Requirements. Once a Practicing Affiliate has completed a
- 92 five (5) year cycle in which he or she was required to complete the Points and Standards and Ethics
- 93 Education Requirements, the Practicing Affiliate must include in the certifications of his or her written
- 94 reports a statement whether he or she has completed the continuing education program for Practicing
- 95 Affiliates of the Appraisal Institute.
- 96 Because this Certification Standard Rule applies only to Practicing Affiliates, it is inappropriate for
- 97 Designated Members, Candidates and non-members to use the statements found in C.S.R. 1-5.
- 98 Practicing Affiliates must use the exact text of the statement required by this Rule. If a Practicing Affiliate
- seeks to explain his or her failure to complete the continuing education program of the Appraisal Institute

- for Practicing Affiliates, extreme care must be used. The Appraisal Institute does not deem other activities as equivalent to its continuing education program. Misleading statements that relate to a Practicing
- Affiliate's qualifications violate Ethical Rule 5-5 of the Code of Professional Ethics. Misleading statements of any kind may violate Ethical Rule 1-1(a) of the Code of Professional Ethics.
