**Henderson's G. Herbert Pritchett Honored
as Appraisal Institute's 'Volunteer of Distinction'**

He has been president of G. Herbert Pritchett & Associates, located in Madisonville, Kentucky, since he founded the firm in 1987, and has been in the valuation profession for more than 40 years. He received an associate's degree from Madisonville Community College.

Pritchett's volunteer activities have included serving as deacon at various churches and being active in politics, including serving as chairman of the Democratic Executive Committee of Henderson County, Kentucky; vice president of finance and a member of the Democratic State Central Executive Committee; and serving as campaign manager for various locally elected officials. Pritchett also is active in the Glema

Mahr Center of the Arts, the Madisonville Community College Building Fund and the Aussie Rescue Foundation.
