Lehmayr has been the director of appraisal services with High Associates, Ltd., in Lancaster, Pennsylvania since 2007, and has been in the valuation profession for 30 years. He received a bachelor's degree in marketing from The American University, in Washington, D.C.

His volunteer activities include being elected to a four-year term as commissioner of Spring Garden Township, serving as chair of the township's Zoning Hearing Board and Planning Commission and serving as board member of the York Area United Fire and Rescue.
