

Designated Member Statuses

The Appraisal Institute reserves the right to audit an individual's eligibility for any status. The Appraisal Institute may make appropriate adjustments to an individual's status, as necessary

There are two types of Designated members in the Appraisal Institute, Practicing and Non-Practicing. Each type may have an additional status with a lower dues level in which certain eligibility is required.

Practicing Designated Member

A Practicing Designated Member is a Designated Member in good standing who provides Service(s) as defined by the Code of Professional Ethics. Some Practicing Designated Members may also hold the status of Past President Designated Member, Life Designated Member, or Semi-Retired Designated Member. Practicing Designated Members may qualify for additional statuses below that may represent a different dues level.

1. Practicing Semi-Retired Designated Member

A Practicing Semi-Retired Designated Member is a Designated Member in good standing who is at least sixty (60) years of age and earns no more than \$25,000 in each calendar year from Services(s) as defined by the Code of Professional Ethics. The Board of Directors shall establish such dollar amount from time to time.

2. Practicing Life Designated Members

A Practicing Life Designated Member is a Designated Member in good standing who has held membership in the Appraisal Institute or its predecessor organizations continuously for at least forty (40) years and is current in the payment of full membership dues.

Non-Practicing Designated Member

A Non-Practicing Designated Member is a Designated Member in good standing who does not provide any Service as defined by the Code of Professional Ethics. Some Non-Practicing Designated Members may also hold the status of Temporarily Non-Practicing Designated Member, Retired Designated Member, Past President Designated Member, or Life Designated Member. Non-Practicing Designated Members may qualify for additional statuses below that may represent a different dues level.

1. Non-Practicing Retired Designated Members

A Non-Practicing Retired Designated Member is a Designated Member in good standing who is at least sixty (60) years of age and who does not provide any Service as defined by the Code of Professional Ethics.

2. Temporarily Non-Practicing Designated Members

A Temporarily Non-Practicing Designated Member is a Designated Member in good standing who is temporarily unavailable to provide any Service as defined by the Code of Professional Ethics due to: poor health or physical disability; family obligation or responsibility; military service; or other good cause shown.

3. Non-Practicing Life Designated Members

A Non-Practicing Life Designated Member is a Designated Member in good standing who has held membership in the Appraisal Institute or its predecessor organizations continuously for at least forty (40) years and is current in the payment of full membership dues.

Additional statuses may be available to National Past Presidents of the AI and its predecessor organizations.
