Volunteer of Distinction

The Appraisal Institute's recognition program honors volunteers for their service to the Appraisal Institute, to the real estate valuation profession and to their local communities. Each month, the Appraisal Institute will recognize one honoree in each region.



WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Any Designated member, Candidate for Designation, Practicing Affiliate or Affiliate in good standing who makes contributions to the Appraisal Institute, the appraisal profession or their local community is eligible to be recognized.

HOW ARE NOMINATIONS MADE?

Chapter executive directors will submit nominations, on a form provided on the Appraisal Institute's website, to their region executive director. Any Designated member, Candidate, Practicing Affiliate or Affiliate may make suggestions to chapter executive directors. Region executive directors should submit nominations to Brent Roberts, broberts@appraisalinstitute.org.

WHO MAKES THE SELECTIONS?

Region executive directors, in consultation as necessary with their region chair and/or vice chair will select honorees each month for their regions.

WHAT ARE THE CRITERIA?

Honorees will be selected based upon their volunteer service to the Appraisal Institute, to the real estate valuation profession and to their local community.

WHAT DO HONOREES RECEIVE?

Monthly honorees for each region will receive a certificate suitable for framing. The honoree's chapter also will receive a certificate.

HOW ELSE ARE HONOREES RECOGNIZED?

The Appraisal Institute's website will list each month's honorees. Additionally, honorees will be highlighted in Appraisal Institute emails such as Chapter FYI, the monthly President's Message and Appraiser News Online. And the Appraisal Institute will send a news release announcing the honor to media outlets in the honoree's community. Chapters may also choose to recognize honorees of the chapter (e.g., a newsletter article or a presentation at a chapter meeting).
